The 1991 Lions opened up the season with 14 consecutive wins, six by shutout. Six of those wins featured five goals or more for TCNJ. A tie against fourth-ranked Cortland broke the 28-game winning streak, but kept alive a 34-game undefeated streak. After a victory over conference-rival Kean, TCNJ entered the NCAA tournament as the #2 seed. Consecutive shutouts advanced the Lions back the semifinals, and a win over Lock Haven moved TCNJ back to the finals where they repeated as champions with a win over Bloomsburg. Gina Carey earned the Honda Broderick Award for all of field hockey this season. She was joined by Jill Shipley and Cathleen Filippello on the All-American list.

The 1985 Huskies opened up with a string of five games in which they scored four goals or more in each contest, shutting out the first three opponents. Over the next ten games, Bloom shut out eight opponents to push their record to 15-0 with an aggregate score of 57-7 at the conclusion of the regular season. After Shippensburg won a strokeoff in the next contest, Bloom beat Kutztown to move into the NCAA tournament as a regional host. The Huskies won the regional and advanced to the semifinal, where they lost to eventual champion TCNJ 1-0. They defeated Drew to take third place. Karen Hertzler was named National Player of the Year and was named an All-American along with Donna Graup and Carla Shearer.
