The 2008 Bears split the opening weekend before going on a five-game win streak that saw them outscore opponents 33-5. A double-overtime loss to Division I West Chester stopped that run, but Ursinus followed that game up with a 13-game win streak. Led by All-Americans Jennie Moore, Kait Sutherland and Nikki Thren, the Bears won the Centennial Conference regular season and tournament and entered the NAAs as a host seed. A pair of wins at home moved Ursinus to the semifinals at home, where they fell to eventual champion Bowdoin to end the season. Moore was named National Player of the Year.

The 1982 Diplomats opened up with a pair of wins before a 2-0 loss to Division I Ursinus. Three more wins were followed by a loss to Lafayette and a 3-3 tie against Elizabethtown. That stretch ignited a six-game win streak with four of them by shutout to close the regular season. A pair of wins in the conference tournament followed; first beating Etown 1-0 and then a win over Drew to claim the title sent the Diplomats to the NCAA tournament. F&M defeated Salem State in the quarters before falling to eventual champion Ithaca in the semifinals. A win over Denison gave the Diplomats the third place trophy. Leanne McFalls, Sandy Swope, Donna Zaccaria and Patty Reich earned All-American honors that season.
