The 2011 Polar Bears swept through the regular season, posting a 14-0 record to enter the NESCAC tournament as the top seed. Seven of those wins were by shutout, including a stretch of four consecutive. Two more shutouts in the tournament moved the Polar Bears into the final, where they defeated Middlebury for the second time that season and won the title. As the top seed in the tournament, the Polar Bears shut out both opponents at home in the regionals to advance to the NCAA semifinals with a 19-0 record. In the semifinals, Bowdoin fell to Midd in their third meeting of the season. Ella Curren, Katie Herter and Elizabeth Clegg earned All-American honors.

18-2 • NCAA Runners-Up

The 1992 Lions lost the opener to Millersville 2-1, but from there ran off 18 consecutive wins to advance to the NCAA final. A string of three consecutive shutouts was halted in a 2-1 win over FDU, but TSC put together another run, this time of five straight. A 3-1 win over Rowan kept the streak alive, and five more wins, by an aggregate score of 19-1, brought the Lions into the NCAA tournament as the second seed and an undefeated record in Division III. An overtime win at home over Southern Maine moved TSC into the regional final against rival Rowan, and the Lions beat them for the third time that season to advance to the semifinals at home. An overtime win over Messiah was the 18th consecutive win for TSC, but a 1-0 loss to William Smith ended the season. Cathleen Filippello, Cathy Swezey, and Kira Kuzman all earned All-American honors for the Lions.
