The 1983 Lions opened with a pair of shutouts and never looked back, rattling off 19 consecutive victories in their first 19 games. Fourteen of those games were shutouts, and for the second consecutive year TSC won the Virginia Tech Invitational. The streak was stopped at the hands of Division I Rutgers, but the Lions closed out the regular season with another shutout win. In the NCAA tournament as the top seed for a third consecutive year, the Lions went 3-0, including a 2-1 win over Ithaca, reversing the decision from the previous year. Margaret Casey, Lori Jung, Diane Smith and Carol Whitehouse all earned All-American honors.

## v MESSIAH 2010

The 2010 Falcons opened up with a pair of wins over NCAA-bound teams in Juniata and Ursinus before losing 1-0 on the road to Eastern, who also earned a berth in NCAA. A pair of shutouts over Rowan and Salisbury were followed by an overtime loss to Lynchburg in a neutral-site game. From there, Messiah rattled off 10 consecutive wins, including eight by shutout, to close the regular season at 14-2, with five wins coming against NCAA tournament teams. A pair of wins in the conference tournament sent the Falcons into NCAAs as the top seed. A 7-0 win over Lynchburg in the second round avenged one loss and Messiah advanced to the semis with a win over Salisbury. A 4-0 win over Ursinus moved the Falcons to the finals where they lost in strokes to Bowdoin. Julie Barton was named National Player of the Year and she earned All-American honors along with Kourtney Ehly, Amber Good, Gina Kellett and Kayleigh Stewart.
