The 1982 Lions continued their hot streak from the season before, stretching their unbeaten streak to 46 over the last two years and returning to the NCAA final. TSC recorded 16 shutouts on the season, including a stretch of five consecutive and another stretch of four consecutive that included three Division I opponents. The defense surrendered two goals in a game only once in the 27 contests—two in the loss to Ithaca in the NCAA final. Diane Smith earned All-American honors.

## CNU 2007

16-3 • NCAA Second Round

The 2007 Captains lost their opener to Division I Davidson and then defeated Division II Catawba before launching into their Division III schedule. CNU started it with a bang, defeating Salisbury 2-1. That game launched an eight-game shutout streak in which the Captains outscored their opponents 27-0. The shutout streak stretched to 614:01 with a 3-1 win over Johns Hopkins, a time that ranks in the top-10 all-time in Division III history. Four more wins followed before Ursinus ended the 15-game winning streak with a 1-0 victory. A win over Frostburg closed the regular season and CNU earned a bye in the NCAA tournament, where they were stunned by Springfield 2-1 to end the campaign. Jacque Mayer and Ashley Hay earned All-American honors.
