The 1991 Huskies opened the season with nine consecutive shutouts while scoring 34 goals over that period. Kutztown scored but Bloom won 4-1, and the Huskies rattled off three more shutouts to push the streak to 13 and an aggregate score of 50-1. A 1-0 loss to F&M stopped the run, but behind All-Americans Trudy Horst, Denise Miller, Gisela Smith, and Beth Bowman, Bloom won four more to close out the regular season. The Huskies notched a pair of shutouts to win the PC and enter the NCAA tournament as the top seed. A pair of 2-0 clean sheets in the regional at home moved Bloom into the semifinals, where they scored an overtime goal against Hartwick to advance to the final against undefeated Trenton State.

The 1994 Panthers opened with a tight 1-0 overtime win and a 3-2 triumph in back-to-back conference games, but that ignited a pair of shutouts and two more wins by a 11-3 aggregate to move to 6-0. A 1-1 tie with Williams broke the winning streak, but Midd remained undefeated and reeled off six more wins to close the regular season, three by shutout, giving the Panthers six in total for the season. A pair of wins at Williams moved Midd to the final weekend, but at Messiah the Panthers lost their first two games of the season to finish in fourth. Sarah Martin, Nancy Hastings, and Marnie Virden earned All-American honors.
