The 2014 Sea Gulls leapt out of the gates, winning their first four games by an aggregate score of 35-1. A series of five wins over ranked teams followed, with the first four on the road, to improve to 9-0. A loss at home to Catholic ignited a 23-1 run over the next four games, before the Sea Gulls won a wild 6-5 overtime victory over Mary Washington. Three more wins, including an overtime win over CNU in the CAC final, sent Salisbury into the NCAAs as a regional host. Two shutouts at home moved the Sea Gulls to the semifinals, where they lost to Bowdoin. Summer Washburn and Courtney Jantzen were named All-Americans.

The 2007 Dutchwomen opened up with two wins over NCAA-bound teams, and then swept through the regular season, winning 19 consecutive games, including six by shutout. Along the way they defeated four teams bound for the post-season. They advanced to the finals of the conference tournament where they faced Messiah for a second time that season. A loss in the rematch ended the 19-game streak, but LVC still advanced to the NCAA tournament as the #4 seed. A pair of wins at home moved the Dutchwomen down the road to the semifinals at Ursinus, where they lost to eventual national champion Bowdoin in the semifinals. Mimi Sullivan and Alex Wolfe earned All-American honors.
